

Chas. Voght, a farmer living northwest of town had the misfortune last Sunday to lose four head of good work horses and have one rendered practically useless for work in the future. The horses in some manner gained access to the granery in the absence of Mr. Voght and family and ate freely of the newly threshed wheat stored away in the granery and four of the horses which were valuable animals died from the effects of eating the grain while a fifth horse was so stiffened in the legs as to make him worthless and unfit for work.
