

OBITUARY

Andrew Anderson was born in Sweden in 1870 where he remained until he was about twenty years of age and in 1890 came to New York city. Here he remained for three years and in 1893 came to North Dakota and settled northwest of town where he has since resided. For the past two years he had been afflicted with diabetis and had been taking medical treatment most of the time and seven days before his death went to the Fargo hospital where he died on November 22d at five o'clock in the afternoon.

He was a member of a large and highly respected family and leaves his mother and father, four brothers and three sisters to mourn his death. Three of his brothers, Theadore, Axel and Carl reside here and his brother William resides in New York city. Of his three sisters Mrs. Nels Johnson is the only one residing here and Mrs. Alquist and Mrs. Charles Johnson reside in New York city also.

Funeral services were held in the Presbyterian church last Friday afternoon, Rev. Hewson of Wimbledon preaching the sermon, and interment took place in the Courtenay cemetery.
