

Death of Mrs. Anton Haas.

Mrs. Anton Haas died at her home out southeast of this city Wednesday noon, death being caused by a cancer from which she has been a sufferer for over a year. About a year ago Mrs. Haas went to St. Paul to consult specialists in regard to this disease and she was operated upon and this afforded her temporary relief, but the improvement proved to be only transitory and the malady has been becoming more and more aggravated until she finally succumbed to its dread ravages.
