H. J. Murphy went to Enderlin on Sunday to attend the funeral of his cousin, Conductor Dan Murphy. The many friends of the conductor were greatlyshocked to hear of his sudden demise on Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock. He had come in from his run about a week before and not feeling well took a layoff but no serious consequences were looked for, but he suddenly became worse and passed away, the immediate cause of death being heart failure. He is survived by his wife and two children but they were not privileged to be at his side when the snmmons of death came, being on a visit in the east.
