

OBITUARY.

It is our sad duty to announce this week the death of Mrs. S. J. Ouren. Last week it will be remembered that Mr. Ouren took his wife to Minneapolis to see if she could not get medical treatment by way of operation that would help her, but on an examination being made by leading physicians of Minneapolis she was told that her disease had gone too far and that nothing could be done for her. Mr. Ouren then started on his homeward journey with his wife Tuesday evening and she died Wednesday morning on the train between Valley City and Sanborn. Her remains arrived in Cooperstown Wednesday evening. She had been a severe sufferer with womb disease for a year or so which finally ended in her death.
