

Grandma Brown, mother of J. N. and B. B. Brown and Mrs. Zimmerman, died very quietly Tuesday night, at 9:30, at the grand old age of 88. Mrs. Brown is an old pioneer of Griggs county, and was beloved by all who knew her, and was affectionately called "grandma" by everybody. She has been virtually helpless for the past two years and for several months has had nothing but liquid food for nourishment. Last fall she fell down and hurt herself and has kept her bed ever since, and from that time to the time of her death she has gradually declined. Her end was peaceful though she was unconscious and she slept away. She was a patient, christian lady, and often told the loved ones who nursed and comforted her that she wished her savior would take her to that eternal home from which no traveler returns, because she did not want to be a burden to them. Never a word of complaint did she utter all through these weary months, but bore her sufferings with christian fortitude. Notwithstanding all the trouble and discomforts occasioned by one in her condition, the home without this dear old grandma will indeed seem as though the light had gone out of it. The funeral took place at the Congregational church Thursday morning, at 10 o'clock, Rev. G. R. Searles officiating.
