## What They Have Done and are Doing in Steele County.

### Good Returns.

James Cochran came from Westfield, Wisconsin, in 1880, bringing with him 3 horses and settled on a half section of land in Highland township, where he has since resided. At present Mr. Cochran owns seven horses and sixteen head of cattle, besides farm machinery and tools necessary to carry on his farming. Last year he had 100 acres of wheat from which he threshed 2,400 bushels; 20 acres of oats from which he threshed 1,000 bushels.
