

Fourth of July Meeting.

Minutes of the second 4th of July meeting, held June 16th, 1890.

Geo. H. Iseminger in the chair.

H. H. Wasem chosen as secretary pro tem.

Minutes of the last meeting read and approved.

Geo. H. Iseminger was made permanent chairman.

Committee on finance reports \$74 raised.

Moved that we have a free-for-all trotting race for a purse of \$30—\$20 to first and \$10 to second—mile heats, best two out of three. Carried.

Moved and carried we have a free-for-all running race for a purse of \$25—\$15 to first and \$10 to second—half mile heats, best two out of three.

Moved and carried that we have a 4 minute trotting race for a purse of \$20—\$13 to first and \$7 to second—mile heats, best two out of three.

Moved and carried that we have a pony running race for a purse of \$20—\$13 to first and \$7 to second—half-mile heats, best two out of three.

Ten per cent of the purses is to be paid as entrance fee, and two or more to enter for each race. Entrance fees to be received up to noon of the 4th and to be paid to P. P. Rice, Treasurer.

Moved and carried that L. A. Jacobson be elected to act as marshall of the day, with Dan'l Nelson to assist.

Moved to adjourn to the call of the chairman.
