At the meeting held Jan. 12th, 1891, there were present H. H. Wasem, J. P. McMahon, Jas. Loney and A. S. Moote.

Minutes of the meeting held Dec. 8th, 1890, were read and approved.

On motion the following bills were allowed and ordered paid:

Bill of L. E. Marsh for salary as town clerk for six months	\$25 00
Bill of Merriell Bros. & Luca, five tubular street lamps, \$23 00; four extra globes, 2 60; two gallons kerosene oil, .40; total,	26 00
Bill of Beldler & Robinson Lumber Co., lumber for lamp posts,	4 15
Bill of A. S. Moote, making four lamp posts, \$2 00; repairing town pump, .75; total,	2 75
Bill of A. M. McLaughlin, three months salary as town marshal, \$6 25; draying for Hallowe'en, 1 00; total,	7 25
Bill of R. D. Stewart, making one lamp post,	50
Bill of Geo. McLain, digging five post holes and setting five posts,	2 50

On motion the lighting of the street lamps was let to Geo. McLain at \$4 00 per month.

On motion A. S. Moote was appointed a committee for purchasing a barrel of oil for street lamps and securing a suitable place in which to keep it.

On motion meeting adjourned until the evening of Feb 9th, 1891.
