

Proceedings of the Board of Trustees.

An adjourned meeting of the board of town trustees, held June 9th, 1890, in the office of E. J. & J. P. McMahon, was called to order by President Wasem at 8:40 p. m.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

On motion, bill of Alonzo Roddy was allowed and ordered to be paid, the bill counting as follows:

1. For acting as inspector of the town meeting held April 26th, 1890,	\$2 00
2. For carrying the returns of above meeting to Sherbrooke,	1 00
3. For acting as inspector of the town election held May 17th, 1890,	2 00

On motion the clerk was instructed to obtain a town order book, a treasurer's account book, a justice's docket, and a record book.

On motion the clerk's salary was fixed at \$50 for the ensuing year, payable quarterly.

On motion the marshal's salary was fixed at \$25 for the ensuing year, payable quarterly; and he was required to wear a badge of his office.

Mr. Elwell then made a report concerning his department; after which he was instructed by motion to ascertain, by examination, what buildings there are within the corporate limits of Hope which need or require fire apparatus for use in case of fires, and to notify all owner or occupants thereof to procure such proper apparatus as the fire-warden may direct.
