

Proceedings of the Town Trustees.

Hope, N. D., May 19th, 1890.

First meeting of the trustees of the town of Hope.

Present H. H. Wasem, 1st district; J. P. McMahon, 2d district; James H. Loney, 3d district; Daniel Nelson, 4th district; Adam S. Moots, 5th district.

All the trustees having taken the oath required by law, the election of president was then proceeded with.

On motion H. H. Wasem was elected temporary chairman of this meeting and A. S. Moots was elected secretary pro tem.

Moved that the president of the board of trustees be elected by acclamation. Carried.

On motion H. H. Wasem was nominated and elected president of the board of trustees for the ensuing year.

On motion it was carried that the bonds of the justice be \$100 with two sureties.

On motion it was carried that the bonds of the clerk and assessors be fixed at \$100 each with two sureties.

On motion it was carried that the bonds of the marshall and treasurer be fixed at \$500 each with two sureties.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned to meet at J. P. McMahon's office on Thursday, at 7:30 P. M.
