Justice of the Peace was accepted and placed  
on file.

On motion the vacancy of marshal was filled  
by the Board appointing Arthur McLaughlin  
to the office of marshal, vice Walden, he not  
being able to qualify, owing to his absence  
from town the coming year.

On motion the Clerk was ordered to procure  
the necessary books and vouchers for the offi-  
ces so filled, and also to procure a Seal for the  
Board of Trustees of the town of Hope.
