

VICTORY!

THE REPUBLICANS ELECT A STRAIGHT COUNTY TICKET, WITH ONE EXCEPTION.

Almost all the State Ticket Receives a good Majority at the Hands of Steele County Republicans.

Partial returns have been received from all but one precinct in the county, which give all the candidates on the Republican county ticket majorities with the exception of States Attorney. Some doubts are had as to whether Bartlett is elected or not, but Enger and Sklener receive good majorities over their opponents. Below we give the vote as nearly correct as possible this week.
