Signal Service for June 1890, the month ly mean temperature was 68.5. Maximum 99 at Fort Sully, Rapid City, Grand Forks and Woonsocket, Minimum 80 at Aberdeen. Mouthly mean precipitation for the states, 5.71 inches. Greatest monthly 10.53 inches at Milbank. Least monthly 2,19 Inches at Vermillion. Greatest in any 24 consecutive nour 4.40 inches at Milbank.

The monthly Meteorological Summary for Riverside, Steele Co., N. D., for the month of July, 1890: Monthly mean temperature, 72.4; maximum, 102 on the 27th; minimum, 50 on 5 days. Precipitation, 2.60 inches. Greatest in any 24 consecutive hours, 1.60 on the 12th. Total since January 1st, 1890, 8.19 inches.
