

Weather Report.

Monthly meteorological summary of the North and South Dakota weather service, in co-operation with the U. S. Signal Service for November, 1890.

Temperature: Monthly mean, 34.2; highest monthly mean, 43.9 at Spearfish; lowest monthly mean, 27.8 at Wild Rice; maximum, 89 at Milbank; minimum, -6 at Woonsocket; range for the State, 94.

Explanation: The minus sign, (-) prefixed to a number indicates below zero.

The monthly mean temperature was about 6.2 degrees above the normal.

Precipitation: Monthly mean, 0.46 of an inch; greatest monthly, 3.20 inches at Webster; lowest monthly, 0.03 of an inch at Fort Buford.

Monthly summary for Riverside for December 1890.

Temperature: Monthly mean, 16; greatest daily mean, 35; least daily mean, -6; maximum, 53; minimum, -22; range, 72.

Precipitation: 0.06 of an inch.

Annual summary for Riverside for 1890.

Temperature: Annual mean, 36.1; maximum, 102; minimum, -42; range, 144.

Precipitation: 14.72 inches; snowfall 16 15 inches.
