

Weather Report.

According to the monthly meteorological summary of the North and South Dakota weather service, in co-operation with the U. S. signal service, for the month of July, 1890:

The monthly mean was 72.9; highest monthly mean, 77.3 at Fort Sully and Scranton; lowest monthly mean, 66.4 at Gallatin, maximum 108 at Steele, minimum 36 at Aberdeen.

Monthly mean precipitation for the states, 1.79 inches; greatest monthly, 4.39 inches at Yankton; least monthly, .13 of an inch at Rapid City.

The monthly summary for Riverside, Gallatin P. O., for the month of August, 1890: Monthly mean, 65.9; maximum, 100; Minimum, 36; precipitation, 2.43 inches.
