Proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners.

Sherbrooke, Steele County, N. D.,
March 29th, 1890.

Special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to call of County Auditor, for the purpose of apportioning to each township its quota for jury list and consulting with assessors and such other business as may properly come before the Board.

Present: Commissioners Lewis Thompson, Chairman; John P. Fense, Martin Hanson, Alexander Curry and L. C. Day.

The apportionment was made as follows:

Newburgh, Eger and Hope, 20 each; Primrose, Edendale and Broadlawn, 15 each; Bergen and Colgate, 10 each; Norway, Greenview, Riverside and Lincoln, 7 each; Clifton, Norman, Highland, Golden Lake, Sherbrooke, Pickert and Willow Lake, 6 each; Melrose, 5, making a total of 200 names as per requisition from Clerk of Court.

The commissioners consulted with assessors until adjournment.
