

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS.

Of The Board of County Commissioners.

Sherbrooke, N. D., March 14th, 1892.

Board of County Commissioners met in special session, pursuant to call of County Auditor. Present Chairman Pease and Commissioners Schjeldahl, Williams and Curry.

The minutes of the previous meetings were then read and on motion the same were approved.

On motion the Bill of K. A. Wadel for medical attendance on Nels P. Sandtorf, for \$50.00 was allowed at \$33.00

On motion the following bills were allowed and ordered paid from General Fund:

John Arneson was allowed \$4 48 from Gopher Destruction Fund for 112 gophers killed during April 1891.

On motion the Board adjourned until 1-30 p. m.

Board reconvened pursuant to adjournment at 1-30 o'clock p. m. Present, Chairman Pease, Commissioners Schjeldahl, Williams, Curry and Day.

On motion the following Resolution was passed, v'z:

Whereas, Steele County is entitled to the immediate possession of the premises now occupied by L. A. Freeland, and described as follows: The north sixty five feet of lot 21 and all of lots 22, 23 and 24, Block 24, in the Town of Hope in Steele County, because said L. A. Freeland has failed to pay the rent due said Steele county for the month preceeding the tenth day of March, 1892, according to the terms of a certain Lease in writing made by and between Steele county, party of the first part, and L. A. Freeland party of the second, on the tenth day of February, 1892.

Therefore it is moved and ordered, that Samuel L. Linn be and is hereby authorized on behalf of Steele County to demand of L. A. Freeland immediate possession of the aforesaid premises and to hold the same if obtained, until ordered by this Board. But if L. A. Freeland holds possession and refuses to give the same to Steele county, after due demand is made, by Samuel L. Linn, then and in that case, the States attorney of Steele County to bring at once an action for the recovery of the possession of the aforesaid premises.

On motion an Auctioneers License was ordered issued to Tom Power, upon the payment into the County Treasurer, of Ten Dollars.

On motion the bill of C. R. Jackson, for M. K. Nybo, poor person, was allowed and ordered paid in the amount of \$5 00

On motion the following bills were allowed and ordered paid from the General Fund:

On motion the following resolution was carried, viz:

Freeland has failed to comply with the terms of the Lease entered into with Steele Co. on Feby. 10th 1892, it is therefore moved and ordered that Steele County the party of the first part, declares said Lease null and void and refuses to be bound thereby and order the Treasurer of Steele county to refuse to receive any rents from said L. A. Freeland under said Lease, and the County Auditor is requested to notify the Treasurer of this motion.

On motion the Board adjourned.
