

Death of Mrs. H. C. Brewster.

Mrs. H. C. Brewster died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Gertrude Montgomery, in Harvey last Monday night, of spinal meningitis, aged 65 years.

Mrs. Brewster was one of the pioneer residents of this section and always took a prominent part in social affairs. She was a charter member of Prairie Chapter, O. E. S., and was its secretary for several years. She was also a member of the Presbyterian church, Myotis club and the W. C. T. U.

The body was brought to Sanborn for interment and was buried from the Presbyterian church this afternoon, Rev. J. H. Armstrong conducting the services.

There was a profusion of flowers, the Star sent an emblematical star and roses, the W. C. T. U. white carnations and Myosotis Club chrysanthemums.
