Undertaker Shannon last Friday took up the remains of Rev. A. B. Prindle and those of Mr. Covell, Mrs. Prindle's son, and prepared them for shipment to Mrs. Prindle's home at Ray, Ind. It will be remembered by old-timers that the Rev. Mr. Prindle, a superanuated Methodist minister, and his step-son, Mr. Covell, were killed by lightning in July, 1883, while working on the second floor of a house they were building. Mrs. Prindle was also in the house but escaped with a severe shock. By the way, it may not be generally known to the presentday residents of Sanborn that the first death in the neighborhood was caused by lightning—being that of a young son of Mr. Samuel Zingg.
