

## W. A. Baker Commits Suicide.

There have been three suicides within ten days in this section of the state, W. A. Baker, of Hannaford, being the last to go out into the unknown by his own hand. The Times-Record has been unable to get accurate details of Mr. Baker's death, but it is reported that he shot himself Monday and his body was found the following day by a neighbor who called at his farm residence, a few miles out from Hannaford. Mr. Baker's wife and family were in this city at the time, having taken up their residence here last fall for the purpose of permitting the children to attend the school. Mr. Baker is understood to have been in comfortable financial circumstances. Besides his farm property, he owned the residence which the family occupied here.

Some twenty years ago Mr. Baker was a resident of Valley City and was a partner of Ole Rushfelt in the harness business.
