

Another Barn Burned.

Sunday morning the barn of John Faust, about a mile east of Sanborn, was burned with its contents, including seven horses. Two lives were lost, Mr. Faust's son, age 12, and a boy named James Collins, age 16. The two boys and a hired man were sleeping in the barn at the time, the latter escaping by jumping from a window. Mr. Faust came out of the house and taking a ladder went to the window in an endeavor to get the boys out. Reaching in he seized one of the boys by the wrist, but before he could get the lad out the floor gave way and the boys dropped into the flames. Mr. Faust was badly burned about the right arm, face and neck.

The origin of the fire is unknown, but as numerous barns of well-to-do farmers have been burned in this county within a short time, it is possible the barn burner is again getting in his work. The sympathy of the entire community is extended to Mr. Faust and Mr. Collins, the latter of whom has recently become a citizen of the county.
