

James G. White's Death.

Last night about 12:30, James G. White, of Hannaford, died at the residence of his cousin, Maj. Frank White, in this city, of consumption. He had been in the city for two weeks under treatment, but caught a cold a day or two ago which was the immediate cause of his death. His wife and two brothers, John White of Stillman Valley, Ill., and Thomas White, of Iowa, arrived in the city Monday and were with him during his last hours. The remains will be shipped to Stillman Valley tonight for interment.

Mr. White was about 60 years of age and had been a resident of North Dakota for sixteen years, having conducted an extensive farm near Hannaford. He leaves besides his wife, two daughters, both married, who reside at Stillman Valley.
