Death of Capt. Pattison. Capt. W. L. Pattison of Dazey, one of Barnes county's best known citizens, died at his home at Dazey of a complication of diseases. The remains were brought to Valley City Sunday, the funeral being held at the Methodist church, Rev. Foster preaching an eloquent sermon. The interment was made in Hillside cemetery and the impressive ceremonies of the G. A. R. were performed at the grave. Capt. Pattison's health has been poor for a number of years. Wounds and disease acquired while fighting in defense of the nation undermined what would otherwise have been a robust constitution. Withal, he was always cheerful and hopeful. He was one of the most prominent members of Josiah S. Weiser Post, G. A. R., from its organization. Many acquaintances sincerely mourn the death of a brave soldier and good citizen.
