

## OBITUARY.

Sarah E. Fallett, nee Ohr, was born in Maryland, February, 14, 1852. When she was quite young her parents moved successively to Indiana, Illinois and Woodburn, Clark county, Iowa. At that place she was married to Chas. C. Fallett, from whence after a wedding trip to the home of the latter at Ithaca, New York, Mr. and Mrs. Fallett moved to Mount Morris, Illinois. After four years residence there, in 1880 they moved to Mapleton, N. D., and thence to Oriska in 1896, where they have made their home for the past eight years. They were both members of the Congregational church here, and Mrs. Fallett was a member of the lodge of Royal Neighbors.

Mrs. Fallett having felt ill for some time, Mr. Fallett took her to Fargo, October 15, to receive medical treatment in the care of relatives, little thinking he should never bring her back again.

The doctors there pronounced the disease cancer of the bowels and incurable. After a little more than three weeks Mrs. Fallett died without much suffering November 8, at the home of Mrs. Brown, her son's mother-in-law, and was buried in Fargo from the Congregational church, Friday, November 11. Mrs. Fallett leaves her husband, who continues to live in Oriska, and three sons in Fargo. Leland, fourteen years of age, is the youngest.

In her life here and duties Mrs. Fallett has made many friends and her death makes a vacancy in the lives of many outside her family circle, thus showing a life well lived.
