G. Simenson, one of the early settlers of the county, died last Thursday while on a visit to his only daughter, Mrs. Martha Torgerson, of West Salem, Wis. He has been in Wisconsin since last November. Mr. Simenson was about 78 years of age, and his death is attributed to his advanced age. He came to this county in 1878 or 1879 and was one of the first settlers on the west side of the river, his home being about ten miles southwest of the city. He was the father of S. G. Simenson.
