

# Earl Feske Dead

Sentinel-Courier—Earl Willard Feske, sixteen year old son of Mr. and Mrs. John Feske of Helena township and a Junior in the Cooperstown high school passed away at his home Monday morning following an illness of about two weeks.

The cause of his death dates back to an illness suffered by the young man about a year ago, when he suffered an attack of influenza which resulted in a serious mastoidal trouble. What was thought to have been a successful operation was performed at the time, but it appears that trouble was renewed a few weeks ago when the young man caught a bad cold. Inflammation of the brain was the immediate cause of death, the patient being delirious for the four or five days preceding his death.

The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon at the Feske home with Rev. Crites of this city officiating. Burial was made in the Hartman Memorial cemetery near the Feske home. A body of Cooperstown high school students was in attendance at the funeral.

Earl Willard Feske was born March 6, 1907, and was the youngest of a family of four children. He was born in Broadview township and has been a resident of Griggs county all his days. Finishing his school work in the rural district he entered Cooperstown high school three years ago and was a very fine student, pushing ahead in spite of the handicap he has had the past year in the form of illness. With his parents two brothers, Rudolph and Pearl, and one sister, Violet, mourn the loss of this young man.
