

# Transient Injured at Revere

Sentinel-Courier: Cooper: Joe Amberlie, a transient of unknown address met with injuries at Revere Wednesday that were of a most serious nature. An amputation of his left leg was necessary and other serious results may yet follow.

Amberle was riding a freight train, hanging to a ladder on one of the cars. The train he was riding met another at a siding and he was brushed to the ground and under the wheels of one of the trains. He was rushed to Hannaford, where Dr. Brimi of Cooperstown and Dr. Wolverton of Hannaford took care of his immediate needs and then rushed him to a hospital in Fargo.

In addition to the leg which had to be amputated, the unfortunate man has a very badly mangled right foot that may possibly have to be amputated, a bad fracture in the right shoulder and serious scalp wounds.

The accident happened about 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon. Amberle is is said to be a man of about 35 years.
