Section foreman John Peters is now off duty with his arm in a sling as a result of an accident on the speeder last Friday. The crew had started home on the speeder and while it was moving slowly, John reached over to apply belt dressing to the drive belt which was slipping. While doing this his sleeve was caught in the belt, which drew his arm into the flywheel and dislocated the elbow joint. Besides this injury a number of ribs were fractured and other bruises sustained. He was hurried home and taken to Cooperstown' where medical and surgical were given, and in a few weeks he will be able to go to work again.
