

Rural Route

From Sutton

The local postmaster received notice from Washington this week that rural route No. 1 from Sutton has been provided for and will be in operation on and after November 16. That is the route will be established on the above date if the required number of patrons, 60, have erected suitable mail boxes or filed written agreements to do so with the postmaster in time for report on the same to be in the hands of the post office department not later than November 1. Prospective patrons on the proposed route will be interviewed in a very short time and all necessary arrangements made so the service may begin without any delay.

The route will be 26.25 miles in length, and as submitted by the inspector, will cover the following territory: from Sutton 5 miles west to Haakon Halvorson's corner; then south 3 miles; east 2 miles; north two miles; east two miles; south 2; east 1; south 1; east 1; north 1; east 1; north 3; then west to Sutton.

The salary to be paid the carrier will be \$1860 per year and his schedule for leaving will be 8:00 a. m. and returning 4:00 p. m. No information as to the appointment of a carrier was given, but this matter will be taken care of in due season by the appointment of an applicant eligible by a previous examination or by holding an open competitive civil service examination.
