Albert Campbell, a Tyrol township farmer, was shot to death by John Slabber, a neighbor, last Friday. Slabber went to Cooperstown and gave himself up, later attempting suicide in his cell in the county jail. Not much is known as to the cause of the trouble. He is reported to have said to Mrs. Campbell immediately after the shooting: "That man has been bothering me for six years." Campbell was a prominent farmer, and about 55 years old.
