

# A. M. Hewson

Memorial services for Rev. A. M. Hewson were held Sunday at the Sutton Methodist church with Rev. John Cawthorne of Wimbledon in charge. It was a solemn occasion for those who had heard their minister so many times during the years that are gone. Particularly sad was the closing of this service with the realization that it was the closing scene in the sixteen years of ministry Mr. Hewson had given to the Sutton charge.

The funeral was held Tuesday in the Wimbledon school gymnasium which was packed to the limit with sorrowing friends who had come to pay their last tribute to the memory of a man whose life was a shining example of righteousness before the whole world.

Rev. Hewson's last public utterance was less than twenty-four hours before his tragic end, when without preparation he gave an address at a reception to Rev. Cawthorne and family, that was pronounced one of the greatest short sermons he ever delivered.
