

The body of Milo Kingsley arrived Monday from Bainville Montana, having come by train to Lakota from where it was brought to the home by truck. The details of the terrible affair, as told to us, are about as follows: He had been employed in a lumber yard, but for various reasons lost his job. There was apparently some disagreement as to their future course which brought matters to a crisis. The deed had been planned beforehand as Milo wrote a letter to the auditor in charge of the yard advising him of his intentions and directing him what to do with his insurance and with the children. The tragedy occurred early Thursday morning last week before the children had left for school, and it is reported the boy was attracted by the shots, entering the house as his father turned the gun on himself. The weapon used was a 30 calibre army rifle. It appears that Mrs. Kingsley had appealed to the auditor for protection the evening before, saying she expected Milo to kill her any moment.
