Passes Away

Mrs. Margaret Green, who has made her home for several years at Martin McWethy's, passed away Tuesday at the age of 89. Her health, until two weeks ago, had been good, but an attack of grip proved to be the fatal malady.

Margaret Cassels was born in Streetsville, Ontario, April 26, 1826, and died April 6, 1915, and lacked twenty days of being 89 years old. She was married to Wm. Green, also of Streetsville, in 1846. In the year 1885 she moved with her family to Courtenay, where she had since resided.

She leaves to mourn their loss two brothers, Robert and Wm. Cassels of Chesley, Ontario, one sister, Mrs. Wm. Bradford of Courtenay and two grandchildren, Mrs. Martin McWethy and Wm. Watson of Sutton.
