

Aged Man Dead

K. O. Nesheim passed away Monday afternoon at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Joe Bergstad, from the infirmities of old age, after more than three years of almost absolute helplessness. His age at death was 80 years, two months and two days. The body was shipped from here Wednesday, to Simcoe, where burial will be made by the side of his wife who died a number of years ago.

Mr. Nesheim was born in Norway January 14, 1840. He came to North Dakota in 1900, settling at Simcoe. There are six sons and two daughters living. They are, Martin of Los Angeles; Gilbert of Portland Oregon; Sever of Granville; Carl of Towner; Albert of Rake, Iowa; Theodore of Frost, Minnesota; Mrs. E. F.
