Bill Peters Dead

W. H. Peters died Monday afternoon at Fargo of tuberculosis, from which he had been a sufferer since a year ago. At that time he had a severe attack of influenza, leaving him in a weakened condition, from which he could not recover. The funeral was held Tuesday afternoon in Fargo, his brother John Peters, and Alex Arigros, who is related to him, being there to take charge of it.

Deceased was 30 years of age.

He came to this country from Greece about ten years ago, but in 1912 returned to his native land, where he spent 15 months in the Balkin war with the Turks. Returning to this country in 1914 he came to North Dakota and until a year ago was section foreman here. He is survived by his father, mother, brothers and sisters in Greece, besides his brother, John, of Sutton.
