

Death of a Pioneer

Mrs. Anna Thompson, mother of Martin Thompson, passed away at his home Saturday, December 15, at 12 o'clock. Deceased was 83 years of age, and had been very low for several weeks. She is survived by three daughters, Miss Helen Thompson of Fargo, Mrs. L. P. Jaeger and Mrs. Ingmon Sorenson, both of Eau Claire, Wisconsin and Martin, the only son, near whom she had lived for many years.

Mrs Thompson was one of the pioneers of the northwest, having come to America from Norway in 1871—forty-three years ago.
