The Jamestown Alert has the following account of the death of an old citizen of this place: death of Andrew Anderson, of Wimbledon, occurred Saturday at the city hospital. He had been afflicted with cancer of the throat for a year or more and had undergone one surgical operation in Minneapolis a year ago, but without benefit. He was slowly choking to death, and was brought to the hospital about a mouth ago. Dr. DePuy removed a large portion of the cancerous growth and relieved the sufferer somewhat, but the last three days of his life he breathed only through a tube inserted in his throat. Mr. Anderson was about 60 years of age. His wife is at present confined to her bed with rheumatism, but a nephew is expected to arrive today
