

SKETCH OF THE LIFE OF  
JOHN PETER DICK. WHO  
DIED Nov. 17th. 1898.

His grandfather was an officer in the Revolutionary war, giving most of his property as well as his service to the cause of liberty. His father was a captain in the war of 1812 and was through the Mexican war. Mr. J. P. Dick tried to enlist in the Rebellion in behalf of his country and love of humanity but was rejected on account of a crushed ankle, received years before.

The deceased was born in the state of Maryland, March 29th. 1825. Emigrated with his parents to Fremont, Ohio in 1840.

Was married to Catherine Miller at Fremont Ohio in 1856. He was bereft of his companion in the year of 1860, leaving two sons one two years old and one two weeks old. He came to N. Dak. in 1893 to live with his son Frank. He leaves the two sons to mourn his loss.
