

E. W. Fish, for many years a business man of Valley City, committed suicide in Minneapolis Sunday. Less than a year ago he sold his drug store at Valley City which he had conducted for twelve years and recently purchased another store in Fargo. Sunday of last week he was arrested on a charge of selling liquor without a permit, on complaint of a "spotter." He furnished a cash bail for his appearance in court the following Wednesday and left for Minneapolis Saturday evening. He arrived in the city Sunday morning, engaged a room at the Russell Coffee House where he was found by the proprietor about 6 o'clock that evening dead. He left a note to notify Sam Blank at Valley City, and took morphine. He was popular, an excellent business man and in good circumstances.
