

## BODY FOUND—

Fargo Forum: The body of the little Parker boy who was drowned in the Red river last winter when he went through a hole in the ice, was recovered Monday on the old Stewart farm about three miles north of Fargo. The body was discovered by a farmer and has been fully identified.

It was brought to Fargo by Sheriff John Ross of Cass county, having been found on the North Dakota side of the [river and was placed in a Fargo undertaking establishment. It will be remembered that there was some question as to the boy having been drowned. It was believed that he might have been kidnapped by his father, who had been separated from the mother.
