

# Noted Educator And Clergyman Passed Away

## Dr. N. J. Kildahl Victim Of Stroke of Paralysis

In the death of Rev. Dr. Kildahl Thursday the Norwegian Lutheran Church of American lost one of its biggest men and foremost educators.

Rev. Kildahl was for several years president of St. Olaf College at Northfield, Minn., and deserves much credit for bringing that school to the position it now takes among the leading educational institutions of the Northwest. Some years ago he became professor at the Luther Seminary, St. Anthony Park, which position he held at the time of death. He was also at the time of his death vice-president of the Norwegian Lutheran Church of American, a position he had filled with credit for several years.

Dr. Kildahl did not attain a very old age but has had a very eventful career as clergyman, educator and writer and the hundreds of thousands of Scandinavians in the American Northwest had found in him a leader whose work will be gratefully remembered.

The cause of death was a stroke of paralysis suffered about ten days prior to death.
