

# Double Tragedy

Fargo Forum: Choked to death by her husband, who then killed himself by a shot through the heart, the body of Mrs. Lee Park was found at the Park farm near Solomon, Kansas, by neighbors, according to her father, Dave Curfman, farmer near Page, N. D., who returned to Page yesterday with Mrs. Park's body.

Two children, aged 7 and 9, had gone to school shortly before 9 a. m., Jan. 9, leaving only a 20 months old child with the parents when Mrs. Park was murdered. Mr. Curfman said the only reason he could assign for Park's action was trouble over money matters.

Mr. and Mrs. Parks moved to Solomon two years ago from Luverne, N. D., where they lived for a year, having gone to Luverne from Page. Miss Curfman had formerly married Alfred Johnson of Hope, and lived there until his death, after which she married Parks. Their home life at Hope was declared by friends to be amiable. From Hope they moved to Page. Both of the older children are children of Mr. Johnson.

Funeral services are held in Page today for Mrs. Parks. Mr. Park's parents live near Solomon, and he is to be buried there by his relatives.
