

# Ku Klux Klan After Kirby

Grand Forks, N. D., Sept. 23.—

Samuel Kirby, so-called "miracle doctor" of Northwood, claims that he has received two threatening letters signed with the initials "K.K. K." and ordering him to "move or be moved."

He says he will give \$5,000 for evidence leading to the identification of the writer.

Kirby was arrested several months ago on a charge of practicing medicine without a license but was acquitted by a jury in the district court at Grand Forks. His method of curing sickness rests mainly on "painting" the throats of his patients with a strong solution.

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Sutton Reporter: Kirby, the "wonder man" from Northwood was in town Saturday night but his visit was an anti-climax, so to speak, for the crowds he expected to paint were conspicuous mostly by their absence.
