

Luverne Ledger: Sunday evening at 7:30 o'clock occurred the death of Mrs. Christ Jensen. She passed away at one of the hospitals in Fargo where she had been taken two weeks ago for an operation for cancer. Mrs. Jensen was born in Apdrop, Jylland, Denmark, on June 4, 1866. She came to this country in 1882, and settled in Rochester, Minn. It was in the Minnesota city that she met Mr. Jensen, and they were married there on Jan. 2, 1890. Mr. and Mrs. Jensen came to North Dakota in the early days and lived on a farm near Valley City for about seven years. They sold out their place there and got a farm two and one-half miles east of Luverne and have lived happily there for the past twelve years. The funeral services were held from the house at one o'clock, and at the Lund church at two o'clock, on Tuesday afternoon. Rev. Sigurd Olson of Cooperstown officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in the Lund cemetery. The church was beautifully decorated, and the casket literally covered with beautiful floral designs and bouquets sent by the different societies and friends. The pall bearers were old friends and neighbors of the Jensen's. They were Thos. Jorgensen, Jorgen Rasmussen, Ole Sanden, Thos. Thompson, R. J. Jacobson and Peter Nelson.
