As the scratch did not seem very serious she applied a piece of pork to it and seemingly forgot about the accident. Later, however, she became ill and Dr. Brimi was called. Dr. Platou was called from Valley City and a special train was chartered to run up to Cooperstown Sunday with the doctor. On Wednesday she seemed to improve and hope was entertained for her recovery, but she grew weaker and at three o'clock Wednesday afternoon she passed away.
