

Call Is Made for Twenty More Men

The Local Board for Griggs County last Wednesday sent out a second call for men—this time however, for only twenty.

When the checking up of those physically deficient and those with families and the resident aliens, who are exempted upon claim and proof, was about completed last Tuesday, it was found that barely enough to fill the quota, without allowing for those who are sure to be rejected by the District Board and at the mobilization camp, would be left—and a call for twenty more men was immediately made.

The following is the result as given out Tuesday evening by the board:

Pending (examined elsewhere, claims for exemption not completed, etc.)	31
Certified as qualified for military service	82
Rejected on account of physical deficiency	19
Exempted on account of dependent wife and children	21
Aliens (not German) exempted	11
Aliens (German) exempted	1
Did not appear nor make application to be examined elsewhere	3

So far but one alien had failed to claim exemption on that ground. All married men, with one exception, have made claims on that ground. But a few single men, other than aliens, have claimed exemption before the local board, although some of them are expected to make claims before the district board by appealing from the decision of the local board as to physical qualification. Many married men are preparing to claim exemption before the district board on account of being engaged in agricultural enterprises.
