

- Thursday evening's storm did very little damage here compared to the losses that were inflicted on some other communities. At Aneta O. K. Kjorvestad's barn was blown down and eighteen horses killed, one barn was struck by lightning and burned down, and several other barns were destroyed and stock killed. A tree 14 inches through was torn up by the roots and many houses in Aneta sustained more or less damage. At McVile two livery barns and a machine shed were demolished and the store fronts of practically all the business places were blown in, and barns and windmills in this territory were leveled with the ground. Grain fields have been flattened out in this district just like a huge roller should have gone over them. Southern Nelson county evidently was visited by the same kind of storm last Thursday as southern Griggs experienced early this spring.
