

## Martin A. Ueland Retires

Martin A. Ueland has retired from office. Mr. Ueland has for over thirty-two years been in office in Griggs county. In the early history of the county Mr. Ueland was chosen surveyor. He had been educated as a civil engineer in Norway and when he came here there was a demand for his services. His services were so satisfactory that he had been kept in office continually as long as he would qualify.

However, Mr. Ueland, like most of the pioneers, has lost some of his youthful vigor and a couple of years ago he determined not to qualify as county surveyor, having been appointed county superintendent of highways. If he had qualified as county surveyor he would have had to go at the call of anyone and in all sorts of weather and conditions. This he felt was too hard for him. He was again elected last fall, but determined not to qualify or to be a candidate for superintendent of highways, and thus for the first time since the early eighties Mr. Ueland is just a private citizen. We congratulate him upon his long successful record. Mr. Ueland will continue to do surveying for those who need his services.
