

LETTER FROM ZIMKOSKI

Former G. N. Agent Tells About the City of Granite Falls, Minn.

The Enterprise is in receipt of a letter from A. Zimkoski, formerly Great Northern agent here now located at Granite Falls, Minn. We print the letter below:

"I shall always be glad to hear from my friends in Hannaford. That I have some very good friends there. I know from the very nice letters written concerning me by some of them to their friends in Granite Falls and to those I am most surely grateful. And I want to say that although I may be away from Hannaford, I shall always cherish their friendliness towards me.

"Granite Falls is much larger than Hannaford and accordingly proves itself a much more lively place. It is a splendid city of about two thousand population, county seat of Yellow Medicine county, located along the banks of the Minnesota river and in a mountainous section of rare and picturesque beauty. We have some very fine public buildings and residences and beautiful residence streets.

"We have an Indian reservation about three miles from here with about 600 Indians. This section of the country I am told is the center of the old Indian country and many legends of historic interest refer to places in this locality.

"Granite Falls is celebrated as a summer resort, having fine boating, fishing and camping throughout the season.

"We have a fine band of thirty-five pieces and Granite people boast of it as the BEST in the state of Minnesota. Have band concerts every Wednesday and Saturday evenings. Two moving picture houses and a third one under construction.

"People here welcomed me warmly and I feel very much at home. Mrs. Zimkoski and Allene arrived here last week and this week we are quite busy moving into our new home, a new five-room modern flat.
